- **Weather** = Warm days and cool night – Bring your bathing suites!



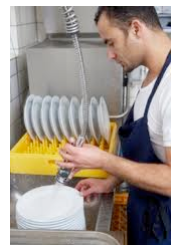
Job Positions:



All restaurant positions, front and back of house: Once an employee arrives to jellyfish they will be assigned to work in the front of the restaurant or the back of the restaurant. Hospitality experience preferred... You will be trained by Jack Chang, the former General Manager of the famed worldwide Nobu Restaurants. Jack has opened 16 of the restaurants worldwide locations.

- **Front of House:** This includes Waiter/Waitress, hostess and busser positions. In these roles you will great customers as they arrive to restaurant. Assist guests with any needs, assists with setting, decorating, clearing of tables. Maintains stock and cleanliness of station with necessary equipment. Sets and clears restaurant tables. Stocks all service stations. Clear dirty table settings and prepares table for resetting. Resets all service ware as prescribed. Maintains stock and cleanliness of stations. Serves guests beverages, breads and butter to begin their dining experience. Transports all dirty tableware from dining room to dishwashing area for proper cleaning. Wait staff also must be knowledgeable of the menu. Know the food, nightly specials, and ingredients and be comfortable carrying large trays of food.

Back of House: This includes kitchen prep and dishwasher positions. Kitchen prep may include assist in the preparation of meals by chopping vegetables, making salads, and putting together entrees. Must be comfortable working with a wide range of kitchen tools and utensils; include chopping knives and vegetable grinders. Additional responsibilities may include storing leftover food, performing kitchen maintenance tasks such as emptying the trash and washing dishes, and testing the temperature of food at specified intervals. May fry, bake or grill meat, poultry and fish dishes. Responsible for preparing dishes prior to being cooked, which may involve cutting or carving meat, fish or poultry; as well as assembling, measuring, and mixing other ingredients for each particular dish. The dishwasher, besides washing dishes in a restaurant, a dishwasher has to clear plates and ensure food scraps and paper debris end up in the correct receptacles. He stacks clean dishes and cooking vessels in an orderly fashion and correctly stores silverware and cooking utensils. His job description frequently includes other cleaning jobs.



- **Hours:** Average 35 - 40 hours per week. Work Hours are NOT guaranteed.
- **Work shifts:** Day, Night, Weekend.
- **Wage (Front of the House):** \$4.65 Plus tips to equal \$7.25 or greater per hour
- **Wage (Back of the House):** \$7.25 per hour
- **Start Date:** Arrive at employer NO later then **May 1st – June 1st, 2012**– No later then May 20th
- **End Date:** **10 and 12 month placements ONLY**

Employment Conditions:

- **Requirement#1:** You must have the ability to bend, push, lift, and carry up to 30kg repeatedly. This job may require physical labor and does require customer interaction. Openness to any task assigned.
- **Personality Traits:** Upbeat, happy, hard working, flexible, love of people, willing to provide superior customer service.
- **Appearance:** clean cut, no visible piercings, tattoos, etc.

Housing & Transportation:

Housing in an Apartment/Host Family.

- You may choose to look for your own apartment or ask LifExchange to assist you in securing a local host family.
 - Housing fee for host family is typically \$100 - \$110 per week + \$300 deposit (\$200 refundable)
